# Reflection on the TCRP Evaluation Process

# Key Pilot TCRP Initiatives

- Observation and Evaluation Process
  - Implementation of process with pilot teachers
  - Collection of pilot data through TCRP survey
  - Focus group on the process at Pupil Free Day and one more in May/June
- Student Growth Percentile
  - Preliminary data run for ELA and Math
  - Principals have access to data but will not use for evaluation this year
- Tripod Student Survey
  - Administering survey beginning of April
  - 10 randomly selected students per pilot teacher/class
- Peer Feedback Survey
  - Administering after Spring Break.
  - Each pilot teacher will receive peer feedback from 3-6 teachers.
  - Survey (see draft) still in development – we will ask for your feedback today

# Human Resource Implications

1. Individually record (on separate sticky notes) specific HR concerns and questions that have been raised related to TCRP.
  - The current teacher contract might be a helpful resource to stimulate ideas
2. On each sticky notes, rate the urgency of each policy issue in terms of when we should have answers:
  - **Level 1:** Clarify in teacher contract or handbook by Fall 2011
  - **Level 2:** Clarify by the end of 2011-12 school year, before provisional placement
  - **Level 3:** Clarify by end of 2012-13 school year, before placement on career path and compensation decisions are made
3. In groups of 6, compare sticky notes and create categories of policy issues you would most like to see addressed.
  - Place the sticky notes in categories, with titles, on chart paper. Place in order of urgency/priority.
